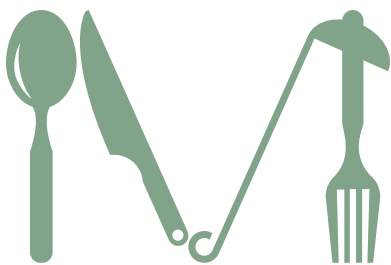
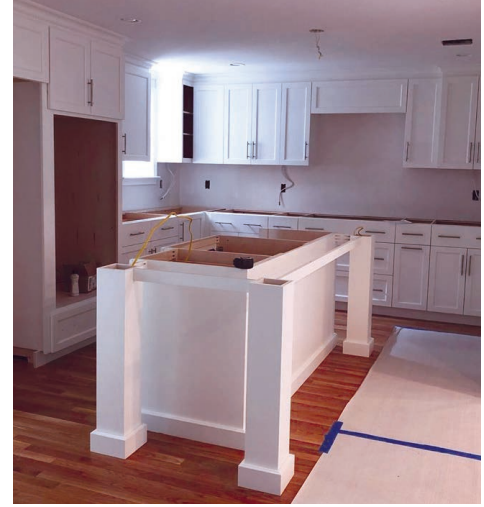


## Restoring A Medfield Landmark

# Creamy Lemon Chicken & Pasta

### ingredients

#### CHICKEN

- 2 boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 1 ½ **tablespoons** of butter
- 1 **tablespoon** of olive oil
- 2 **tablespoons** of garlic powder
- 2 **tablespoons** of Italian seasoning
- **Salt** (to taste)
- **Pepper** (to taste)

#### SAUCE

- 1 ¼ **cups** of chicken stock
- 1 **cup** of heavy cream
- **Salt** (to taste)
- **Pepper** (to taste)
- 1 – 2 **lemons**, juiced
- **Fresh parsley**, for garnish
- 1 **pound** of linguine
- **Parmesan cheese** (to taste)

### instructions

- Set a pot of salted water to boil for your pasta.
- On cutting board, cut chicken in half, widthwise so that you have 4 separate pieces.
- Season chicken on both sides with salt, pepper, garlic powder, and Italian seasoning.
- Heat a skillet on medium-high heat and add butter and olive oil, mixing together to coat the pan.
- Place chicken in pan and cook completely through, until golden brown.
- Once cooked, remove chicken and set aside.
- Water should be boiling at this point. Put one pound of linguine into boiling water and cook until al dente. Once pasta is cooked strain and let it sit.
- Pour ¼ of chicken stock into still hot pan, and scrape up anything left from cooking the chicken.
- Add the rest of the chicken stock and all of the heavy cream and stir.
- Season with salt & pepper, and add in the lemon juice.
- Simmer over medium heat for 10 minutes, and add chicken back into the pan, and spoon sauce over it.
- Remove sauce from heat and let cool. Sauce will thicken as it cools.
- Add cooked pasta into cream sauce and stir. Sauce should stick to pasta and thicken once thoroughly mixed.
- Serve the pasta, chicken, and sauce and garnish with parsley and parmesan cheese.
- Enjoy!
